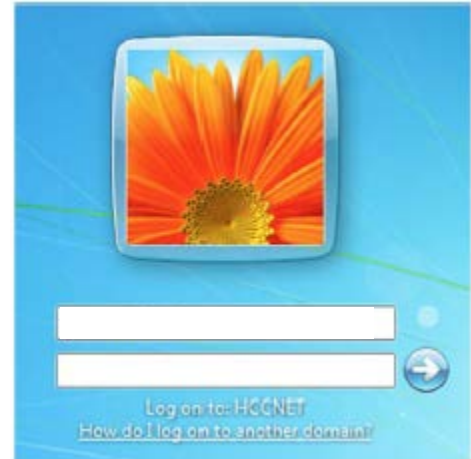

MANAGE MY PASSWORD

If you do not know or have never set your password, or it has expired, you can set/reset it with Manage My Password.

If you are **on campus**, you must first log into a campus workstation using “username” in the User name field and “password” in the password field. Follow the directions below to complete the password set/reset.

If you are **off campus**, simply visit Manage My Password from a computer that is connected to the internet. Go to <http://www.heartland.edu/password> or click the Manage My Password link from the myHeartland Welcome screen at <https://my.heartland.edu>.

LOGGING INTO WINDOWS

To log into your Windows workstation, simply press [Ctrl] + [Alt] + [Del] when prompted to do so and enter your Heartland login name

Press CTRL + ALT + DELETE to log on

and current password in the appropriate fields. Ensure the “Log on to” field reads HCCNET. With your login name and password entered, press [Enter] or click the arrow button:



NOTE: If you are on campus and logged into Manage My Password, you will first need to log out after successfully setting your password.

If all went well, you will receive a “Welcome” message while Windows loads your desktop.

Using Manage My Password

Manage My Password

First-Time Login

1. Create a password
2. Secure your account with security questions

You won't be able to recover your account unless you set answers for your security questions.

Create or Reset Password

Create your password the first time you login or reset your password by answering your security questions.

Change Password

Change your password. You must know your current password and your new password must be unique.

Secure Account

Update your security question answers so you can reset your password if forgotten.
We strongly recommend setting your security questions to secure your account!

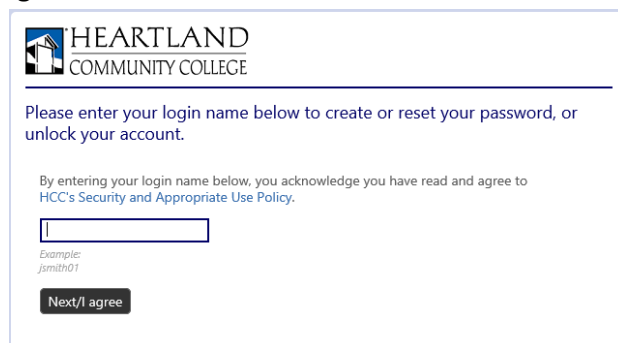
Unlock Account

Unlock your account by answering your security questions. Your account may become "locked" by typing too many incorrect passwords.

1. To create a password for the first time or to reset a forgotten password, click on the Create or Reset Password link.



2. Please read the Security and Appropriate Use Policy, enter your login name and then click **Next/I agree.**

To recover your password or unlock your account you will need to set answers for your security questions.

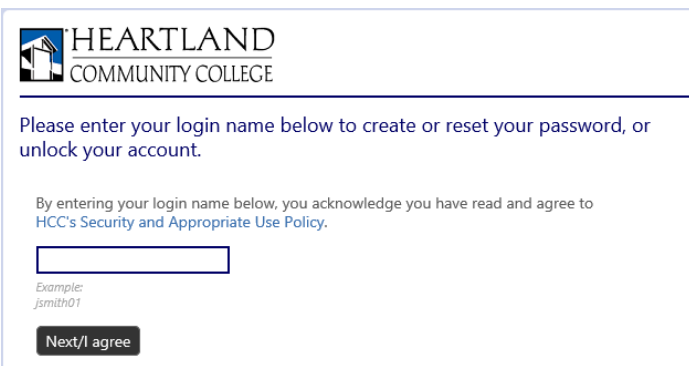
1. Click on the Secure Account link.

2. Click Next to begin the registration process.



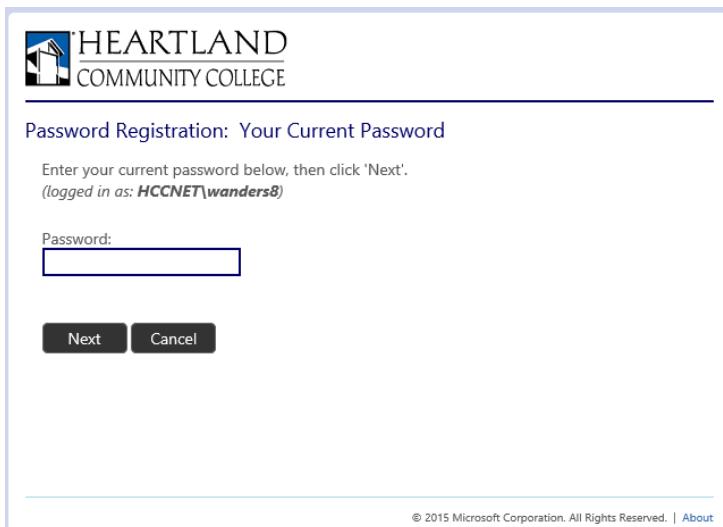

Unlocking your account in Manage My Password

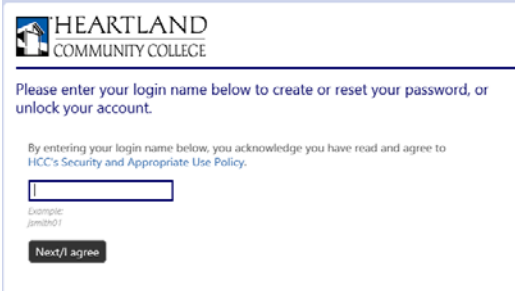
Your account may become “locked” by entering too many incorrect passwords, to Unlock your account follow these steps.

Unlock your account by answering your security questions. Your account may become “locked” by typing too many incorrect passwords.

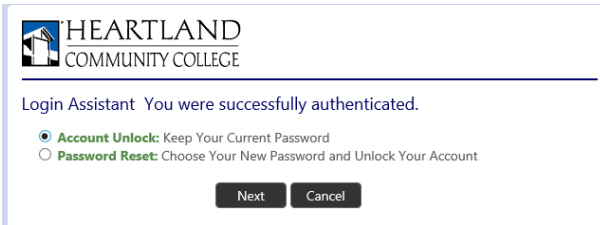
2. Enter your login name in the box, click Next.



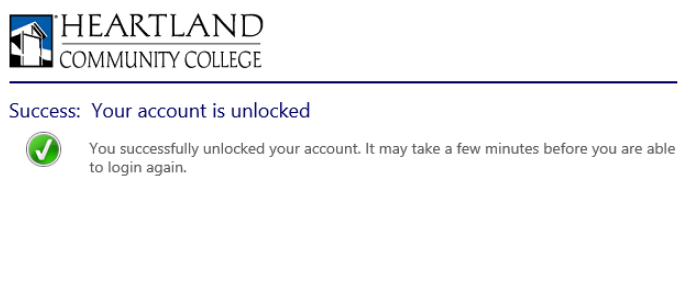
3. Verify your identity, you must answer all three questions.




4. Click **Account Unlock**.



5. Your account has been unlocked and you may close the browser window.



5. You must answer at least three or more of the questions to set security. Answering more will enable the system to randomly choose which questions you will answer.

Each answer must contain at least four characters, and no two answers may be the same.

What is your date of birth (MM/DD/YYYY)? Note: You must enter the date in the format MM/DD/YYYY, including the forward slashes and leading zeros.

What are the last four digits of your Social Security Number?

What is your ID Number?

What school did you attend in 6th grade?

In what city were you born?

What is the furthest place you have traveled?

What is your favorite hobby?


What is the last name of your favorite boss?

What is the name of your favorite sports team?


What is the name of your first pet?
